TIME TO TEST SMOKE ALARMS

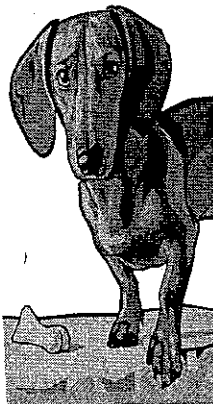
If you haven't done so already, this is a good time of the year to check your smoke alarms and install new batteries.

DISASTER PREPAREDNESS GUIDE # 2 (For your personal comfort and safety from the Executive Council of Homeowners ECHO Journal)

Have stored in a safe location:

1. More than 72 hours supply of food and water
2. Reserve pharmaceutical supply for 2-3 weeks
3. Several flashlights with extra fresh batteries
4. Antibiotic ointment and dressings/bandaids
5. Battery or hand crank operated radio
6. Tarps, plastic or wood to cover holes in roofs, walls, or windows
